







Rose Creek Elementary School Community Council Meeting Notes
Wednesday, April 8th, 2015 at 1:15pm

1. Jennifer Fullmer conducted. Amy Slack motioned to open the meeting and Charlotte Hansen seconded the motion.
2. Charlotte approved the meeting minutes from March 11, 2015. Trudy Fegel seconded the motion.
3. Mrs. Bird reviewed the first draft of the Land Trust proposal for 2015-2016.
 - a) She reviewed goals we talked about last time to use the funds and how she fit those into the proposal. She also reviewed projected expenditures. Ask Mrs. Bird to see these documents if you are interested.
 - b) The council asked Mrs. Bird to look at other schools to see what programs they are using/to think of new ideas on how to use assistants, possibly for math and reading. Also, to ask the teachers for ideas. Maybe ask BYU (since we are a partner school) if they have any research about this. Jennifer will contact a couple of other elementary school committees to ask what their school does. We will discuss these ideas in our next meeting.
 - c) The council discussed some ideas how to diversify the assistants so that we could divide up kids into different learning groups. We discussed ways to think outside the box to use assistants more effectively to enhance all the students' learning -for all the students, not just the strugglers. Could the assistants be used for reading *and* math development? We did note that with such a new idea we would lose the "double group" (SOAR kids get two reading groups) so this is something to consider.
 - d) The council agreed to leave the Land Trust stated the way it is drafted. However, we will look for ideas how to implement our goals.
 - e) Mendee approved the Land Trust proposal. Amy seconded the motion. Members of the council will come into the office to sign the document when it is ready. (The system was down at the time so it could not be printed).
4. The results for leaving the walkway open by the school are in and feedback was positive. The walkway will remain open. Mrs. Bird will contact the district to permanently leave the walkway open.
5. Amy motioned to close the meeting. Jennifer seconded the motion.
