1. Welcome by Amy Slack
2. Approval of Minutes and sign-off of SCC training
3. Michelle Peterson went over the trustland funds. Discussion was on how the teachers use the funds for PLC. Teachers are getting trained on how to make the PLC time for effective.
4. Approval to appoint Breana Nichols. Voting of new secretary, Breana Nichols

5. Cookie dough fundraiser to start for A & B track on Feb 4-Feb 15. Start for C & D track is March 4. Pick up for A track is April 24 and pick up for B,C,D tracks is April 16<sup>th</sup>. We need to have 4 people to help with the cookie dough pick up. Safe walking routes need to be reviewed and changes turned in by Feb 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - a. School safety was reviewed. They are installing a total of 12 more cameras that will be located inside and out.
  - b. The teachers are to keep their doors locked, but can be open during the school day. In the event they need to close them quickly they are already locked. Discussed the buzz system in the classrooms for emergencies.
6. UCAS: Went over the achievement scores. The proficiency shows that we have 241 out of 300 points.
  - a. Language Arts is proficiency of 82%
  - b. Math proficiency is 74 %. 3<sup>rd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grades are working on bring up their numbers. There was a new math program that was fully implemented this year.
  - c. Science proficiency is 78%, at or above district levels
  - d. Direct writing 96%-5<sup>th</sup> grade only
  - e. Need to see how we can improve the gap report for ESL group/ and students with disabilities.
7. Growth- the below proficient growth group is making great progress. Need to find a way to help the other students achieve greater growth.
8. There are mixed reviews of having recess before lunch. We are going to give it some time to getting to system all worked out and give people a chance to adjust.
9. Discussion was on applying for a dual immersion program. There have been schools that really enjoy it. Charlotte Hansen will looking into the positives and negatives and will report back next meeting. Also talked about sending out a survey for the parents and teachers to fill out and get an idea of community interest.
