

## Rose Creek Elementary School Community Council Meeting Minutes

1. Andrea Lefgren opened the meeting.

2. The minutes from the last meeting were previously approved by electronic vote. The copy of the minutes were signed by those in attendance at this meeting.

3. Fund Raiser- the kick-off assembly will be on March 14 at 2pm. We will tell the students how this works and show the prizes. Students may then have their parent's sign a permission slip to receive a box of chocolate to sell. Each day the SCC will provide one person to help Linda with the fundraiser at 9am, the assignments have been made. The fundraiser will go until April 4th.

4. The Land Trust money was discussed. Currently we have extra funds. A proposal was made to allocate \$17,000 maximum on a professional learning community conference and an arts express conference. Hilary proposed a vote and Coleen seconded the motion. The committee voted both in the meeting and electronically to amend the budget. There were 6 in person yea votes and 3 electronic yea votes. No one was opposed.

The budget for next year was discussed. Things that were proposed were a choir, doubling the drama time, a rotation assistant, and chrome books. No decisions were finalized today.


5. A lengthy conversation took place about our safety concerns for the students and the traffic concerns around our school. The safety subcommittee informed the SCC about what was discussed in our meeting with the City, the District, community members, and police.

Here are our actions items from today's discussion:

- Letter to the parents addressing these concerns.
- Safety video addressing these concerns.
- Video addressing specific pick up concerns and encouraging a smoother flow in traffic by moving forward in the pickup area when able. This video will also address u-turns in the school parking lot, parking safely along 3600 west, and other concerns.
- Window clings with the words, "Put Kids First," to encourage drivers to be patient, aware, and safe.
- Raptor prints on the sidewalk to encourage safe walking route and line to help student know where to stop and look both ways before crossing at crosswalks.
- We are going to pilot a procedure where day care busses will be allowed to go in the bussing lane. The goal is to alleviate some of the pressure in the pickup lanes. This will be on a trial basis.
