Action Steps:

To ensure the best possible learning experience for students, we will take the following steps:

- 1. Hire assistants to instruct small groups of students on specific phonics skills. (\$59,000)
 - a. If funds cannot be spent on hourly personnel, we will purchase Chromebooks or laptops for accessing coursework that facilitates reading.
- 2. Acadience assessments will be used at the beginning, middle, and end of the academic year to track progress and make necessary adjustments.
- 3. Small groups of students will receive 95 Percent phonics instruction from trained assistants who will also assess and monitor progress.
- 4. Funds will pay the Instructional Coach to train assistants, work with teachers on student grouping, and oversee the 95 Percent program. (\$38,000)
 - a. If funds cannot be spent on hourly personnel, we will purchase Chromebooks or laptops for accessing coursework that facilitates reading.
- 5. Teachers and assistants will use the Acadience Progress Monitoring tool to track student progress.
- 6. Teachers and assistants will use the PSI and PASI to assess students and update intervention groups every three weeks.

- 7. 95 Percent materials and supplies will be replaced to ensure they are in good condition. (\$2,000)
 - a. If funds cannot be spent on hourly personnel, we will purchase Chromebooks or laptops for accessing coursework that facilitates reading.
- 8. Purchase new iPads and touch-screen Chromebooks to replace old or damaged ones so teachers and assistants can assess and monitor student progress. (\$6,000).
 - a. If funds cannot be spent on hourly personnel, we will purchase Chromebooks or laptops for accessing coursework that facilitates reading.

Based on a large carryover amount, we will use funds to purchase technology programs that support literacy. Such as BrainPop, BrainPop Jr., IXL, and Generation Genius Amount will be \$14,426.25 for IXL, \$5,134.51 for BrainPop and BrainPop Jr., and \$1,000 for Generation Genius for a total of \$20,380.76

We are also hiring more staff so we've increase the proposed budget for both salaries and employee benefits.
