Safe Walking Routes – New signs around round about and new townhomes. Hilary mentioned the guards won't cross kids until 8:30. With breakfast at 8:30 they need to get across earlier. Serving 130 breakfasts a day. Principal has a pantry through the district. Maria mentioned concerns about construction along Water Street to Castlewood neighborhood.

Literacy Program – Walk to Read- program is 95% and tier 2 intervention. Phonics based. Scripted lessons and aides take individual kids to teach. Kids not in Walk to Read get enrichment activities. Groups are fluid, Evaluation every three weeks. K-3 teachers are doing state program about the science of learning to read, Letters Training. 8 hours of online work, full day class per each of 8 modules. Could use the speech therapist to involve the Walk to Read curriculum.

Riverton City – Ways to support teachers and students. This year has been a struggle for teachers. What can the city do to support teachers? Could they highlight more teachers in the Riverton Journal? There was a teacher that was acknowledged at a city night. Would they appreciate gift cards? Could we nominate more of our teachers for current awards? Teacher parties at city park or movie theater party. Friday party at the school. Some sort of recognition – billboards, fireworks

Support student behavior, respect for teachers, and mental health classes to help with students. Should we have a quiet room or fidget toys. Monte Vista has one. Would need a teacher to be there with them. 2 part time Psychologists. Student council will do something with kindness and friendship.
