Professional Learning

Description

Increase teachers' knowledge and skills to improve teaching, learning, and support high quality instruction

Action Steps

- Teachers will Participate in a coaching cycle with Instructional Coach, spend time with Team on Curriculum mapping and planning, and implementing year three Golden Gate Kids
- Teachers will participate in coalition groups and work with other teachers to increase leadership capacity
- Teachers will continue identifying grade-level standards and success criteria during PLCs
- Costs of substitutes for professional development will be covered through TSSA funds
