 - LAN school teachers can monitor what all students are doing on their personal sites.
 Funding comes from technology budget, approximately \$3-4,000 a year. It's also monitored remotely through the district
 - c. School internet is filtered

We need to make it intentional and find the right person to manage it. We need to know that we have a space for it. ASC has a calm down room.
