Walk to read, formerly 95%, is a Phonics based reading program where kids walk to skills specific groups to get instruction. If kids have passed off all of the skills, teachers give them enrichment activities. Walk to read assistants and training are funded by SCC monies.

It was discussed that it is worrisome that many 6<sup>th</sup> graders last year moved to the middle school still struggling with reading skills.

TSSA- Teacher Student Success Act- Provides funds for Instruction Coach, Mrs. Goodwin and the 3 professional development days. The most recent one brought in a JBAT team that taught teachers how to better handle behavioral problems in the classrooms. Teachers have said it was helpful. TSSA also

provides school-based initiatives such as student leadership team mentor stipends, and the cost of subs for walk to read training. It would also cover a stipend for a choir teacher if we can find a current teacher that would be willing to take on those additional responsibilities.

Orchestra is funded through student fees.

Diane spoke about her experience teaching keyboarding. The keyboarding practice and skills also helped to improve other test scores. Keyboarding is no longer required at middle school or high school. Is there an app that the school can invest in? Could it be a part of STEM rotation or morning or afternoon routine?

## Safe Walking Route

Safe Walking routes are posted online by U-DOT. A traffic light in front of Rose Creek is requested every year. Could we have an official lane for cars turning right into the school.

There are no crossing guards during kindergarten only times. Do we have kids trying to walk home without the crossing guards? Do we need additional busses for kindergarteners.

The intersection of Meadow Spring In and 3600 W has several kids crossing it. It comes off of a high traffic commercial area. Do we need another crossing guard there?
